Five-round, single section, Swiss tournament, played at 19th century odds, with set openings:

Grade difference	Higher graded player's colour	Odds	Set '1887' Opening
0 – 20	Toss for colours	None	Evans Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. Nf3 Nc6; 3. Bc4 Bc5; 4. b4)
21 – 30	White	Playing the Steinitz Gambit	Steinitz Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. Nc3 Nc6; 3. f4 ef; 4. d4 Qh4+; 5. Ke2)
31 – 40	White	Exchange (remove White QR & Black QN)	Queen's Gambit Declined (1.d4 d5; 2. c4 e6; 3. Nc3 Be7; 4. Nf3 Nf6)
41 – 50	Black	Pawn and Two Moves (remove Black KBP)	White moves twice at the start of the game: 1. e4 ... ; 2. d4 e6
51 – 60	Black	Knight and Move (remove Black QN)	Sicilian (1. e4 c5; 2. d4 cxd4; 3. Qxd4)
61 – 100	White	Rook (remove White QR)	King's Knight Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. f4 ef; 3. Nf3)
101 or more	White	Queen (remove White Q)	Ruy Lopez Bird Variation (1. e4 e5; 2. Nf3 Nc6; 3. Bb5 Nd4)

Estimated grades will be assigned to players without formal grades.

Rate of play - 15 minutes per player per game. FIDE Laws of Chess apply.

Prizes

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd chess-themed prizes; highest placed club member will hold the Phil Jeffries Trophy for one year
