Five-round, single section, Swiss tournament, played at 19th century odds, with set openings:

Rating difference	Higher rated player's colour	Odds	Set '1887' Opening
0–200	Black (same rating, toss for colours)	None	Evans Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. Nf3 Nc6; 3. Bc4 Bc5; 4. b4)
201–400	White	Playing the Steinitz Gambit	Steinitz Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. Nc3 Nc6; 3. f4 ef; 4. d4 Qh4+; 5. Ke2)
401–600	Black	Exchange (remove Black QR & White QN)	Ruy Lopez Schliemann Defence (1.e4 e5; 2. Nf3 Nc6; 3. Bb5 f5)
601–800	Black	Pawn and Two Moves (remove Black KBP)	White moves twice at the start of the game: 1. e4 ... ; 2. d4 e6
801–1000	White	Knight (remove White QN)	Ponziani Opening (1. e4 e5; 2. Nf3 Nc6; 3. c3)
1001–1200	White	Rook (remove White QR, QRP at a3)	King's Knight Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. f4 ef; 3.Nf3)
1200 or more	White	Queen (remove White Q)	King's Bishop Gambit (1. e4 e5; 2. f4 ef; 3. Bc4)

Estimated ratings will be assigned to players without formal ratings.

Rate of play - 15 minutes per player per game. FIDE Laws of Chess apply.

- Chess themed Christmas prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
